Red Velvet Cake, 7 inch	\$72.00
Proper buttermilk red velvet with a cream cheese frosting that isn't cloying.	
Chocolate Fudge Cake, 8 inch	\$78.00
Three dark layers, ganache between and over. Birthday-proof.	
Kek Lapis Sarawak	\$88.00
Layered by hand under a grill, one thin layer at a time. Takes four hours and it shows.

Hand-rolled with a slow-cooked pineapple jam. The raya staple.	
Kuih Makmur (jar of 25)	\$24.00
Melt-in-the-mouth ghee cookies with a ground peanut centre, dusted in icing sugar.

Whole almond in a buttery cookie, dipped in chocolate and rolled in chocolate rice.	
Cornflake Honey Cups (jar of 30)	\$22.00
